

#215 Diagonal Mesh Scarf and Shawl

Finished Sizes:
 Scarf: Approx. 12" x 70"
 Shawl: Approx. 20" x 70"

Materials:
 5 (8) ske Valley Yarns
 Goshen (48% Peruvian
 Cotton/46% Modal/6%
 Silk, 92yds/50g per sk) #19
 US size 8 needles or size
 needed to obtain gauge

Gauge:
 4 sts and 6 rows per inch
 in St st on size 8 needles or
 size needed to obtain gauge

Abbreviations:
 E5 – 5 elongated sts – knit
 5 sts, wrapping the yarn
 around the needle twice for
 each st. When working
 back on the wrong side,

knit these sts, dropping the second loop off the needle for each st.

Directions:

CO 38 (62) sts
 Row 1 (RS): K1, *e5, k7; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 2 (WS): K1, *p7, k5; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 3: K1, *k1, e5, k6; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 4: K1, *p6, k5, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 5: K1, *k2, e5, k5; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 6: K1, *p5, k5, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 7: K1, *k3, e5, k4; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 8: K1, *p4, k5, p3; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 9: K1, *k4, e5, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 10: K1, *p3, k5, p4; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 11: K1, *k5, e5, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 12: K1, *p2, k5, p5; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 13: K1, *k6, e5, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 14: K1, *p1, k5, p6; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 15: K1, *k7, e5; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 16: K1, *k5, p7; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 17: K1, *e1, k7, e4; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 18: K1, *k4, p7, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 19: K1, *e2, k7, e3; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 20: K1, *k3, p7, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 21: K1, *e3, k7, e2; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 22: K1, *k2, p7, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 23: K1, *e4, k7, e1; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Row 24: K1, *k1, p7, k4; rep from * to last st, k1.
 Repeat Rows 1-24 for 70" or desired length, ending with a RS row.
 BO knitwise on the wrong side to match CO edge.
 Block if desired.
