

#247 Cabled Button Wrap

Wrap:

Cast on 64 sts. Knit 8 rows.

Begin cable pattern (worked over 16 rows):

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 13, & 15: K6, k21, p2, k10, p2, k17, k6.

Row 2 and all even rows: K6, p17, k2, p10, k2, p21, k6.

Row 11: K6, k21, p2, c5f, p2, k17, k6.

Work in pattern until piece measures 10" from cast on, ending with a RS row.

Buttonhole set-up rows:

Row 1 (WS): Work in pattern to last 17 sts; k6, p5, k6.

Row 2 (RS): Work in pattern across row.

Row 3: As row 1.

Buttonhole row:

Row 1 (RS): Work in pattern over 11 sts, k2, BO 2, work in pattern to end of row.

Row 2 (WS): Work in pattern to 2 sts before bound-off sts, k2, cast on 2, k2, p5, k6.

Buttonhole finishing rows:

Row 1 (RS): Work in pattern across row.

Row 2 (WS): Work in pattern to last 17 sts, k6, p5, k6.

Work even in pattern until 19 cables have been made, approx 59" from cast-on. End with Row 4 of pattern. Knit 8 rows. BO all sts.

Finishing:

Weave in loose ends. Block lightly. Sew buttons 3" in from left front edge at 12", 18" and 24" from cast-on.

Finished Measurements:

approx. 15" x 60"

Materials:

6 ske Valley Yarns Hadley (50% wool/50% silk,

50g/109 yds) Suede

US 8 OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Cable needle

3 - 1.25" buttons

Gauge:

16 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St St

Abbreviations:

cable 5 front (c5f) = slip 5 sts to cable needle, hold in front of work. Knit next 5 sts, k5 from cable needle
