

#298 Crocheted or Knit Cookies

Materials:

Valley Yarns Superwash DK (100% superwash merino, 137yds/50g) 1 skein each of colors 04, 05, 01
 US Size D-3 (3.25mm) crochet hook
 US Size 3 (3.25mm) needles

Abbreviations:

ch: chain
 sc: single crochet
 sc2tog: draw up loops in each of next 2 sts, draw yarn through all 3 loops on hook
 kfb: knit in the front and back of stitch
 k2tog: knit 2 together
 ssk: slip 2 sts, one by one, as if to knit, insert tip of left-hand needle up into both sts and knit them together

Crocheted Cookie

Ch 13.
 Row 1: Sc in 2nd chain from hook, then sc in each ch across, tun.
 Row 2: Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn.
 Row 3: Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn.
 Row 4: Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn.
 Row 5: Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 10 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 10 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn.
 Rows 6-11: Ch1, sc in each sc across, turn.
 Row 12: Ch1, sc2tog in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 10 sc, [sc2tog in next 2 sc] twice, sc in each of next 10 sc, sc2tog in last 2 sc, turn.
 Row 13: Ch1, sc2tog in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, [sc2tog in next 2 sc] twice, sc in each of next 8 sc, sc2tog in last 2 sc, turn.
 Row 14: Ch1, sc2tog in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, [sc2tog in next 2 sc] twice, sc in each of next 6 sc, sc2tog in last 2 sc, turn.
 Row 15: Ch1, sc2tog in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, [sc2tog in next 2 sc] twice, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog in last 2 sc, turn.
 Row 16: Ch1, sc in each sc across, fasten off.
 Fold in half and sew or crochet up the bottom, side, and top of the cookie

Knit Cookie:

CO 12 sts
 Row 1 (RS): *Kfb, k3, kfb, k1; rep from *. 16 sts.
 Row 2 and all following WS rows: Knit.
 Row 3: *Kfb, k5, kfb, k1; rep from *. 20 sts.
 Row 5: *Kfb, k7, kfb, k1; rep from *. 24 sts.
 Row 7: *Kfb, k9, kfb, k1; rep from *. 28 sts.
 Row 9: *Kfb, k11, kfb, k1; rep from *. 32 sts.
 Row 11: *Kfb, k13, kfb, k1; rep from *. 36 sts.
 Rows 12-24: Knit.
 Row 25: *K1, ssk, k12, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 32 sts.
 Row 27: *K1, ssk, k10, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 28 sts.
 Row 29: *K1, ssk, k8, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 24 sts.
 Row 31: *K1, ssk, k6, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 20 sts.
 Row 33: *K1, ssk, k4, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 16 sts.
 Row 35: *K1, ssk, k2, k2tog, k1; rep from *. 12 sts.
 Row 36: BO all sts.
 Fold in half and sew up the bottom, side, and top of the cookie.

Finishing:

Embellish top of cookies with beads, french knots, chain stitch, or smaller knit or crocheted frosting 'discs' in contrasting colors if desired. Tuck yarn ends into the interior of the cookie.

Note: Alternatively, you can embellish the top of cookie before sewing the side seams for better access to the wrong side of the fabric.
