

#311 A Fool In Love

In this adaptation of the Fool's Welt, consisting of five knit rows and only one purl row, two very different needle sizes work in harmony to create a scarf that's at once charming, soft, and essential.

Finished Size:

8" x 60"

Materials:

4 skeins Valley Yarns Superwash DK (100% machine washable extra fine merino, 137yds / 50g) color 07 Red
US size 5 and 10 needles or sizes needed to obtain gauge

Gauge:

About 5 sts = 1" in pattern

Note:

To keep edges more even, you can slip the first stitch of every row.

Directions:

With smaller needles, cast on 40 stitches
Rows 1-4: With smaller needles, knit.
Row 5: With larger needles, knit.
Row 6: With larger needles, purl.
Repeat rows 1-6 until scarf measures 60" long or desired length.
With smaller needles, knit 5 rows and bind off.

Weave in all loose ends and block lightly if desired.
