

READY, SET, KNIT

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Qiviuk Webs Narrow Scarf, part 3

Let's start the scarf:

Note: I am tweaking the pattern a bit to allow for beading, so some of my directions will be slightly different from those on the printed pattern. If you decide to do the scarf but want to omit the beads, follow the directions on the pattern.

Suggestion: Before you begin knitting, have the 4 charts enlarged.

Preparation: Pre-string approximately 150 beads onto your yarn using one of the methods described in the beading tutorial.

I have put the Narrow Scarf directions in one list for you. For some of the Narrow Scarf directions, you have to look at the Wide Scarf directions and that means shuffling back and forth between the pages. To me, that means wasting time and possible errors or omissions, so here are the directions in the correct knitting order.

1. CO 6 sts
2. K one row.
3. Work rows 1 and 2 of the **Edging Chart** once, and then repeat rows 3 – 18 of the Edging chart 3 times. Bead in each yarn-over as indicated in the Beading Tutorial.
4. Bind off the 7 sts you have on the needles (this is different from the printed directions).
5. With RS facing (the side where the beads pop through), pick up and knit 1 st in each garter ridge along the straight edge – 25 sts total.
6. Knit two rows (this is different from the printed directions).
7. With WS facing (this is different from the printed directions), work the Eyelet Row once as follows: K1, *yo, k2tog; repeat from * across. Bead in each yarn-over.
8. Knit 4 rows (this is different from the printed directions).
9. With RS facing, K2, work row 1 of **Small Spider Web** chart 3 times, K2. **Be sure to read the chart from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.**
10. **From this point on, maintain 2 garter sts on each edge.**
11. Work through row 6 of the chart; you will end having finished a WS row.
12. Knit 4 rows, decreasing one stitch on the 4th row = 24sts remain.
13. With RS facing, work row 1 of **Lace Holes** chart. **Be sure to read the chart from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.** Knit the 2 garter edge sts, then knit the first 2 sts on the chart. Notice that the next 4 sts are in a box. This means that you must repeat these 4 sts 4 times; at the end of the row, you will have 4 sts left: k2 from the chart, k2 for the garter edge = 24 sts.

14. Complete rows 3 – 6 of the **Lace Holes** chart. In row 3 you will be doing a double yarn-over, so be sure to wrap the yarn twice. On row 4 you will work one stitch into each wrap.
15. Knit 4 rows.
