

A NOTE ABOUT THE KNITTER'S and CROCHETER'S TOOL KITS:

All knitting students should come to class with the appropriate tools. The tools required for each class will vary. As students progress from beginner to advanced knitters, the number and variety of tools required will increase. Below please find suggested tools for the beginning knitter and the intermediate and above knitter:

BEGINNER KNITTING TOOLS

1. Tape measure
2. Safety pins without coils/locking stitch markers
3. Small, sharp, pointed scissors
4. Chibi curved tip and blunt tip large-eyed tapestry needles
5. A couple of crochet hooks, G and H are best
6. Susan Bates Knit Check
7. Skein of worsted weight white cotton yarn for use as stitch holders
8. Emery board
9. Note pad and writing implement
10. Calculator

INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED KNITTING TOOLS

1. Kacha Kacha row counter
2. Small knitting reference book such as *The Knitter's Companion*
3. Round stitch markers in several sizes
5. Magnetic board with magnetic ruler
6. Magnetic board stand
7. Highlighter tape
8. Cable needles
9. A complete set of crochet hooks
10. Yarn requirement guide booklet

CROCHET TOOLS

1. scissors
2. tape measure
3. Susan Bates Knit check
4. locking ring markers or safety pins without coils
5. tapestry needle
6. pencil or pen
