

GRETA'S TUNDRA HAT

Whip up this super-quick hat in no time with Fibre Company's beautiful blend of baby alpaca, merino, and silk. It'll keep your head nice and toasty on a chilly day. Have fun combining colors to create the perfect combination for you.

Abbreviations:

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 together

st(s): stitch(es)

Finished Size:

Average Adult

Yarn:

1 skein of Fibre Co. Tundra (60% Baby Alpaca/30% Merino Wool/10% Silk), Scotia Sea

1 skein of Fibre Co. Tundra (60% Baby Alpaca/30% Merino Wool/10% Silk), Lingonberry

Needles:

US9 and US10 16" circls and US10 DPNs

Other Materials:

Stitch Marker

Gauge:

Approx. 3 st = 1"

Pattern

Cast on 60 sts with MC on smaller needles.

You can join to work in the round right away, however I worked two rows in K2P2 rib flat and THEN joined in the round.

Work in K2P2 rib for about 3" (or however long you want your brim to be. I had plenty of my brim color left over, so I could have gone longer for a folded brim.)

Switch to larger needles and CC, knit 2 rounds.

Continuing in St st, switch colors every 2 rounds.

When piece measures about 8" begin decreases as follows (switch to DPNs when necessary):

Row 1: *K4, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round. (50 sts)

Row 2 and all even rows: Knit.

Row 3: *K3, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round. (40 sts)

Row 5: *K2, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round. (30 sts)

Row 7: *K1, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round. (20 sts)

Row 9: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of round. (10 sts)

Row 10: As Row 9. (5 sts)

Cut yarn, weave end through remaining sts with tapestry needle and pull to close. Weave in ends and wear.
