## SIZE

One size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

18" brim circumference  
10" height

## INGREDIENTS

Shibui Pebble

48% silk, 36% wool, 16% cashmere

224 yds / 25 g

1 skein color A

1 skein color B

1 skein color C

1 skein color D

1 skein color E

Shown in Ivory (A), Chestnut (B), Poppy (C), Trail (D) & Sidewalk (E)

## GAUGE

25 sts & 36 rows = 4" in colorwork pattern on larger needles with  
2 strands of Pebble held together, after blocking

## TOOLS

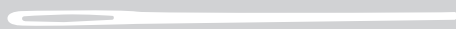
Size 1 (2.5 mm) circular needle, 16" long

Size 2 (2.75 mm) circular needle, 16" long

Size 2 (2.75 mm) dpns



stitch  
marker



tapestry

## NOTE

3x1 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: \*K3, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Hat is worked in the round from the bottom up. Work with Pebble held double throughout. Charts represent stranded colorwork; carry color not in use loosely across WS.

## DIRECTIONS

Using Color A held double (see Notes) and smaller circular needle, CO 112 sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd. Work in 3x1 Rib for 2". Change to larger circular needle. Next rnd: \*K4, M1L; rep from \* to end. 140 sts.

Work Chart 1.

Next rnd: Using B, \*k5, k2tog; rep from \* to end. 120 sts rem.

Work Chart 2.

Next rnd: Using C, \*k4, k2tog; rep from \* to end. 100 sts rem.

Work Chart 3.

Next rnd: Using D, \*k3, k2tog; rep from \* to end. 80 sts rem.

Work Chart 4.

Next rnd: Using E, \*k2, k2tog; rep from \* to end. 60 sts rem.

Work Chart 5.

Break Color E and cont with A only.

Next rnd: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end. 30 sts rem.

Knit 2 rnds.

Rep the last 3 rnds once more. 15 sts rem.

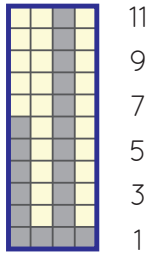
Next rnd: K1, \*k2tog; rep from \* to end. 8 sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving long tail if attaching pompom. Thread tail through rem sts and pull tight to close.

## FINISHING

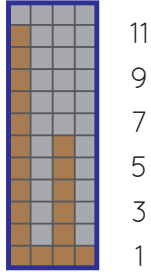
If desired, make a pompom using all 5 colors and attach to hat. Weave in ends. Block.

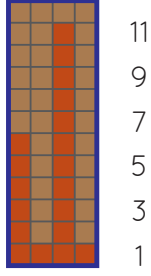

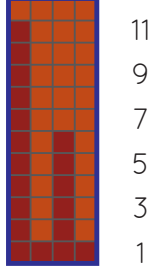
