

## Endless Ombre Cowl

A striped cowl, worked lengthwise on the diagonal, joined with a 3-needle bind off. It can be made into a scarf by casting on 44 sts, then working first 2 rows and last 2 rows in garter st, then binding off.

### MATERIALS

One Jade Sapphire Mini Ombre Collection Kit  
(6 mini sk in 100% Mongolian Cashmere Zageo 6-ply)  
One pair size 7 US needles  
One double pointed size 7 US needle for 3-needle bind off  
Scrap yarn of similar weight for provisional cast on  
Crochet hook size 4.5mm for provisional cast-on

### NOTES

There are 6 color shades in each kit. Shades in the gradient kits should be used as #1 (lightest) through #6 (darkest).

Shades in the multi-color kits should be paired for contrast as desired.

Please search your favorite knitting source for definition of the abbreviations and stitches used in this pattern.

### GAUGE

20 sts = 4" over St st using size 7 US needle or size to obtain gauge

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 7" wide, 60" long

### STRIPE PATTERN

**Row 1** (RS) K2, p1, m1, knit to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

**Row 2** P2, k1, purl to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

### COWL

With scrap yarn, chain 48 for provisional cast-on. Join color #4 and pick up 44 st purlwise in bumps.

### Begin stripes

Join color #1 and work Rows 1 and 2. With color #4 work Rows 1 and 2.

Continue in Stripe Pattern alternating colors #4 and #1.

As these are used up, replace color #4 with #5, color #1 with #2.

Continue with colors #5 and #2. As these are used up, replace color #5 with #6, color #2 with #3.

Continue with colors #6 and #3. When these colors are almost used up, end with color #3 and Row 1, leaving enough yarn to bind off.

### Finishing

Carefully release provisional cast-on and place sts on double pointed needle.

With RS held tog, work 3-needle bind off from WS with color #3.
