

Crochet I Opt-Out Test Class

This proctored 90-minute class session is for those entering the WEBS Expert Knitter's Program who feel they are proficient in the skills taught in Crochet I and would like to test out of the class. Students will be asked to measure gauge (stitch and row) on a pre-made swatch, and explain how gauge is obtained. Students will then follow a short crochet pattern demonstrating all techniques that they should be familiar with before opting out of Crochet I including:

- Chaining correct number of stitches to work stitch pattern
- Understanding gauge—being able to show how to measure stitch and row gauge, interpreting hook size from gauge
- Changing colors
- Increasing stitches
- Working an edging
- Working in the round

This class is pass/fail, and will be offered twice monthly, whenever possible. Dates will be set at the start of each semester.
